What is a General Plan?

Every jurisdiction in California must have a General Plan, which is the local government's long-term framework or "constitution" for future growth and development. The General Plan represents the community's view of its future. The General Plan contains the goals and policies upon which the City Council and Planning Commission will base their land use and resource decisions. California State law requires each City to adopt a General Plan for the physical development of the jurisdiction and any land outside the City's boundaries relating to its long-term planning. Typically, a General Plan is designed to address the issues facing the jurisdiction for the next 20 years.
